

**TERMINATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY  
DECLARED JANAUARY 30, 2026, FOR SECOND WINTER STORM**

**WHEREAS**, on Friday, January 30, 2026, at 1230 <sup>PM</sup> a.m., the Board of Commissioners of Cumberland County, North Carolina, determined and declared that a State of Emergency existed within the unincorporated areas of Cumberland County and any municipalities within it for which the mayor requested inclusion under this declaration.

**WHEREAS**, I, Kirk deViere, Chairman of the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners in accordance with the action declaring the State of Emergency taken by the Board of Commissioners, have determined that the conditions constituting a State of Emergency no longer exist within the unincorporated areas of Cumberland County, North Carolina, or within any of the municipalities within it that were subject to this declaration.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, and the mayors who requested inclusion of their respective municipalities in the declaration, hereby rescind the above referenced Declaration of a State of Emergency and all the restrictions and orders contained therein.

This declaration is effective Tuesday, February 3, 2026, at 12:00<sup>30</sup> p.m.
